Barbara McQuade recommended for U.S. attorney's post

Barbara McQuade, an assistant U.S. attorney, has been recommended for the U.S. attorney's post in the eastern district by U.S. Sen. Carl Levin, D-Detroit, and U.S. Sen. Debbie Stabenow, D-Lansing.

The recommendation to President Obama was made by Levin and Stabenow earlier this week.

If nominated by Obama, McQuade's appointment will require **U.S. Senate** approval. Terrence Berg is currently the acting U.S. attorney.

McQuade is a **University of Michigan** Law School graduate and previously worked in private law practice and as a law clerk to the Bernard Friedman, **U.S. District Court** judge in the eastern district.

Levin and Stabenow also recommended **Wayne County Circuit Court** Judge David Allen and **Oakland County Circuit Court** Judge Mark Goldsmith, for the U.S. District Court in the eastern district.

The senators also recommended that current eastern district U.S. Marshal Robert Grubbs continue in his post.
